

News for the Stalled

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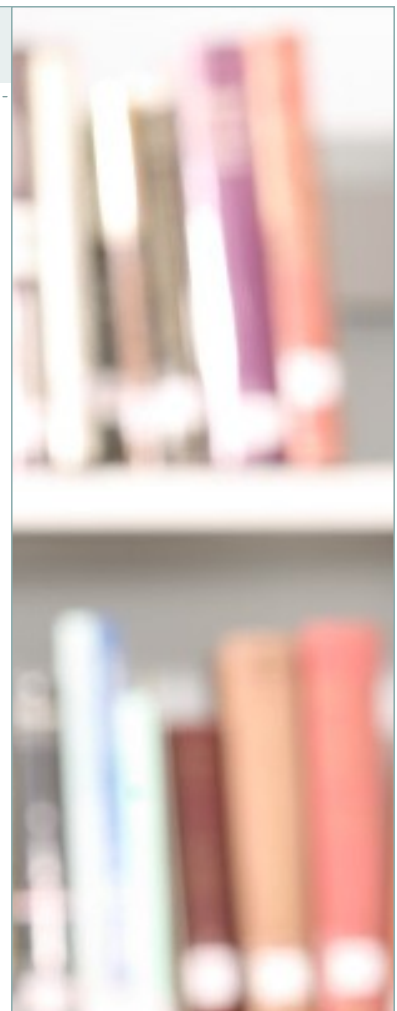
The Vise Library has recently added the option to check out and download an eBook to nearly 75% of the eBook collection. Before this option was added, eBooks could only be viewed while on the Net Library website, and the viewing period expired after fifteen minutes of inactivity. Now users will have the option to download the eBooks to their computer, eReader, or smart phone. Most eReaders are compatible, with the exception of the Kindle. iPhone, iPad, and Android users can also download an app that will allow them to view eBooks.
