



The Office of Career Services and Internships collects data on graduating seniors to identify their plans after graduation. A report is developed from the data that details post-graduation plans (i.e., employment, graduate/professional school). This data is reported to the Office of Institutional Effectiveness and the Office of Institutional Research for use in responding to external and internal requests for career outcomes and graduate school attendance rates. The compiled data listed below is based on the graduate survey responses.
