

## Student Achievement

The Office of the Registrar and the Office of Institutional Research collects data on the retention rates of freshman returning to the University for the sophomore year. The data for the last three academic years follows.

### Retention Rates

Freshmen to Sophomore retention

2013-2014: 64%

2012-2013: 67%

2011-2012: 70%

Data for four and six year graduation rates are collected by the Office of Institutional Research, all are as follows for the last three academic years.
